What is a POD?

A Point of Dispensing (POD) is a place where medications or vaccines are given to large numbers of people in a public health emergency.

What is an Exercise?

Why volunteer?

Volunteers are key to the success of a POD!

Volunteers are needed to:

- Help set up the POD before it opens
- Greet people at the entrance of the POD
- Help people complete registration and screening forms
- Direct people to the appropriate POD station
- Keep POD stations equipped with needed supplies
- Help break down the POD after closing

Doctors, nurses, and other licensed or certified medical professionals are needed to:

- Dispense medication or vaccine
- Provide additional medical evaluation as needed
